Watch the numbers of kids, youth, and adults multiplying.

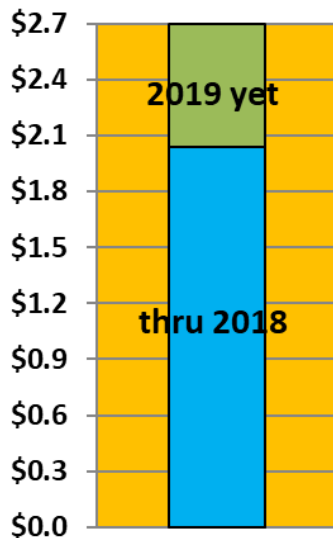

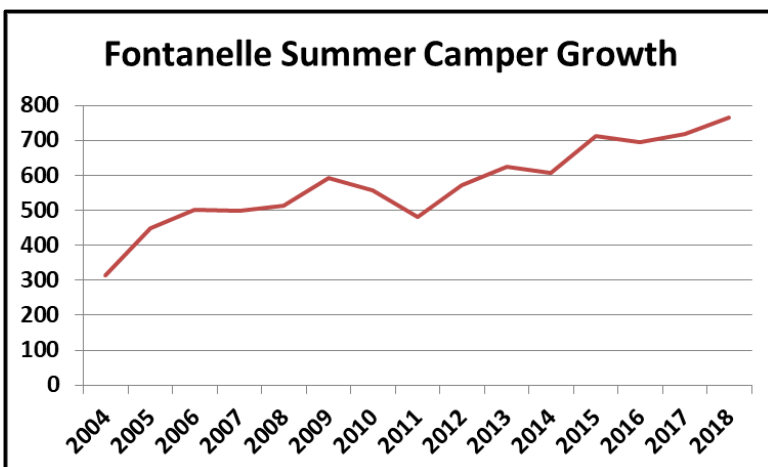

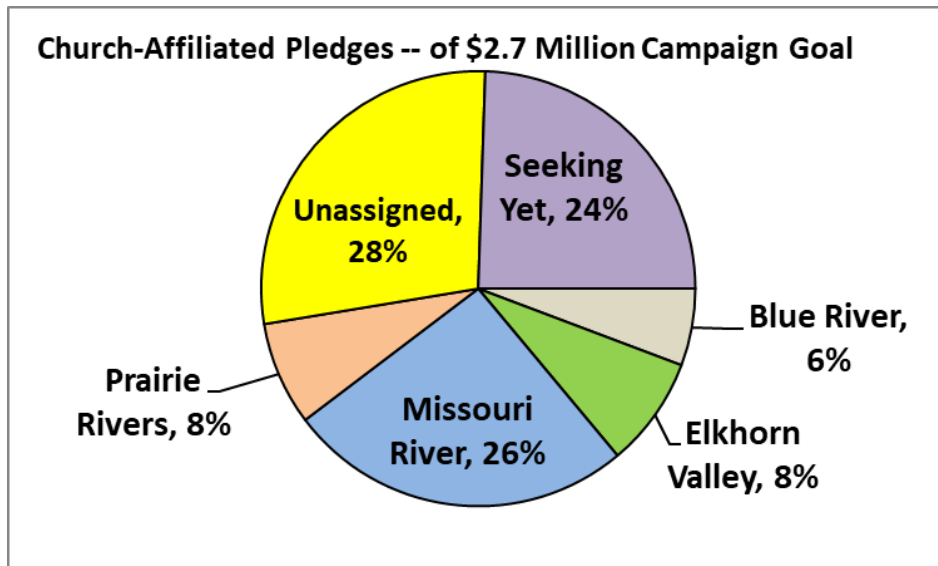


The Retreat Center is needed as soon as possible. **Summer Camp attendance of 765 in 2018 was 47 (or 7%) higher than the record 2017 summer.** We want to provide more lodging so camping and God's work can continue to grow. **Yes, it can grow - if we all work together!**

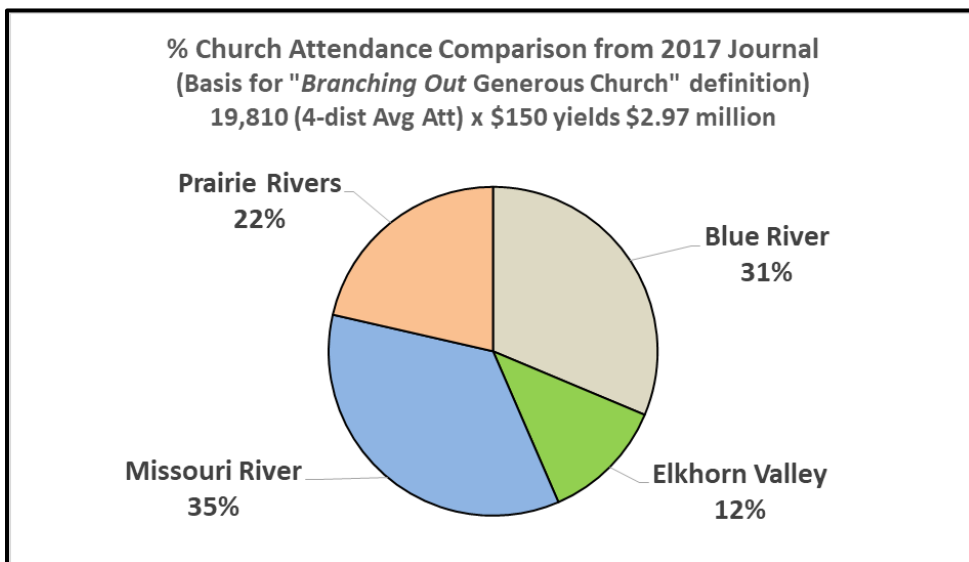
CHARTS of PROGRESS



Seventy-six percent of the \$2.7 million goal has been pledged, comprised of 48% from UM members in eastern Nebraska's four districts and 28% from other donors. So *Branching Out* is seeking additional donors and churches who wish to be a part of Camp Fontanelle's growing ministry for the remaining 24% needed to build the Retreat Center.

NOTE-numbers in the chart have been rounded.

Our districts have different numbers of churches and church attendees. For example, Missouri River (biggest) has approximately three times as many attendees as does Elkhorn Valley (smallest). A *Branching Out* Generous Church Criteria and Recognition has been developed taking into account the size of the church as measured by

attendance to **proportionately divide up the 2.7 million dollar goal.**

EXPLANATION: *Branching Out* GENEROUS CHURCH RECOGNITION

A *Branching Out* Generous Church is a church:

- (1) whose members and groups have contributed a total of at least \$150 times their average 2016 attendance as published in the 2017 Journal, and
- (2) whose contributions have come from Giving Units numbering at least 10% of the 2016 average attendance.

A family counts as one Giving Unit. For a group donation, one Giving Unit will be credited for each \$50. Levels of Generous Church will be recognized as Doubly Generous, Triply Generous, 4X Generous, etc. Churches are encouraged to keep going in their support over the three-year campaign period.

Recognition will consist both of:

- (a) a permanent display at the new Retreat Center, including level of Generosity (1x, 2x, 3x, 4x, etc.) and
- (b) a certificate for display at the local church. Finalized recognition depends on completion of pledges.

EXAMPLE INTERPRETATION and HOW TO USE this information for your church's campaign...

- **Lincoln St Paul UMC** had an average attendance of 486 in 2016 according to the 2017 Journal.
- Therefore its criteria for *Branching Out* Generous Church recognition are ([see second entry below](#)):
 - \$72,900 (or \$150 x 486) ---column 1 and
 - 49 Giving Units (or 486 x 10%, rounded) --- column 2
- Column 3 is the amount of pledges that have been identified as coming from Lincoln St Paul UMC (\$68,162) – this is the total of paid and unpaid pledges.
- Column 4 is the ratio of donations (paid pledges only) divided by the Donations Criteria (\$) of column 1. Multiplying this ratio by the Donations Criteria of column 1 yields the amount of donations – in Lincoln St Paul UMC's case, $0.711 \times \$72,900 = \$51,832$. Similarly their Giving Unit total is $0.61 \times 49 = 30$.
- When both columns 4 and 5 reach 1.0, they will be recognized as a Branching Out Generous Church. Lincoln St Paul UMC is well on its way to this milestone of helping Fontanelle's Branching Out!
- What Lincoln St Paul UMC needs yet for this milestone, is $(1-0.711) \times \$72,900 = \$21,068$ in paid pledges and $(1-0.61) \times 49 = 19$ giving units. Giving units are one family or if a group donation or collection, then one giving unit per \$50.

WHAT'S WORKED FOR US!

This section is an opportunity to share what has worked for you. Then other BUILD TEAM members can benefit and help provide Camp Fontanelle with the retreat center. And the Camp can continue to expand its mission of "Impacting Lives through Intentional Christian Community". - **Omaha Rockbrook UMC** (posted Aug 2018) - We start promoting camp the beginning of March. Our church provides scholarships that cover 1/3 the cost of camp. If families sign up for Guardian Angel or Sonshine Camps early, there is a 50% discount! 1/3 of what is left is a VERY appealing amount for young families to pay. This year the Sunday before a camper left for camp, we had a slide during the church services that showed a picture of them and told what camp they were attending. The Sunday after they returned, we had a slide with a photo from camp. This was a very effective way of making the congregation aware of the opportunities for kids. It also helped them to see how impactful camp is for our congregation. We had no problems raising money to become a Doubly Generous Church because people are convinced that their money will be used wisely and well.
- **Columbus FUMC** (posted Aug, 2018) - We asked Church Council to form a Camping Team to promote Branching Out, summer camp attendance, volunteering and participating at camp events. The Camping Team and Council adopted a \$100,000 goal striving to become a Branching Out Doubly Generous Church (that is 2 times the Generous criteria). We held 5 in-home information (awareness) gatherings. Nearly all attendees have followed up with a generous pledge or donation. Also five church groups have donated. We currently have \$70,000 in pledges/donations. We will have a three-week all-church promotion in worship during September 2018. We have an option to honor a beloved pastor and his wife who were instrumental in camping and sharing God's love. Church people have been responsive even though we have other major projects, missions and an in-church capital campaign going on. We believe over the next three years we can meet our goal, with God's help. (As of Nov 2018 we have \$97,000 in pledges---almost to our goal!)
