SUMMER:



*Support Staff

Support staff encompasses kitchen staff (cooks and assistants), maintenance staff, program assistants, etc. Work behind the scenes to make sure all of the important parts of camp happen!



*Camp Counselors

Lead a group of 8-10 campers throughout the week of camp. This includes Bible studies, field games, morning and bedtime routines, team building, and more. Build relationships with campers and fellow staff in an intentional Christian Community. Must be 18+ years old.



*Deans

Be the leader for a particular program. We have 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 day programs. You would have the opportunity to help create the schedule for the week, lead Bible studies, give messages at worship, interact with staff and campers to make a difference! You communicate how you would like to fill the role!

ALL summer volunteers are required to have Safe Gatherings certification and undergo a background check before arriving at camp
