Available Positions



NEW!!! Junior Staff (about 10 positions)

Explore a variety of staff positions at camp each week. Help facilitate activities, serve meals, help with site clean-up, and more! Must be 16+ years old. Pay Rate \$40/day



Support Staff (about 8 positions)

Support staff encompasses kitchen staff (cooks and assistants), maintenance staff, program assistants, etc. Work behind the scenes to make sure all of the important parts of camp happen! Must be 16+ years old. Compensation based on experience.



Camp Counselors (about 14 positions)

Lead a group of 8-10 campers throughout the week of camp. This includes Bible studies, field games, morning and bedtime routines, team building, and more. Build relationships with campers and fellow staff in an intentional Christian Community. Must be 18+ years old. Starting compensation rate of \$70/day.



Lead Team (about 6 positions)

This is a variety of positions established each summer based on need. This includes but is not limited to, Health Coordinator, Activities Coordinator, Media Specialist, Counselor Coordinator, Spiritual Life Intern/Worship Leader, and Program Coordinator. Starting compensation based on position and experience.

Time off & Lodging



You will receive a 1hr break each day. Most weekends are off from Friday evening until Monday Morning. There will be weekends with opportunities for extra days of pay.



Bunk rooms have twin-size bunk beds, bathroom/shower facilities, electricity, & AC. During weekends staff have separate housing in dorm style rooms that include all of the above amenities. Lead Team members also have separate housing from camper bunk rooms.



You'll receive 3 meals a day. Wi-Fi, and laundry is available for you to use.



Counselors & Support staff receive a daily rate based on their experience and specific set of skills. Bonuses are available for those that finish the summer in good standing or recruit other staff who also finish in good standing.
